THE CITY OF BETHEL WILL HOLD A REGULAR ELECTION TUESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2016, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CANDIDATES TO THE CITY COUNCIL AND VOTING ON PROPOSITIONS AND QUESTIONS

POLLING PLACE AND POLLING HOURS:

- **Bethel #1 – Lower Kuskokwim District Office Board Room**

- **Bethel #2 – Yupiit Piciryarait Cultural Center**
401 Chief Eddie Hoffman Hwy, Bethel

The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day - October 4, 2016.

VOTER REGISTRATION:

You must be registered to vote at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the election. During regular business hours, voter registration forms are available at the Bethel City Clerk's office at 300 State Highway. Forms may also be obtained on-line at www.gov.state.ak.us/lsgov/elections.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS:

A person may vote in the City election only if the person:

1. is qualified to vote in state elections under AS 15.05;
2. is a citizen of the United States;
3. is eighteen years of age or older;
4. has been a resident of the city for the thirty days immediately preceding the election;
5. is registered to vote in state elections at a residence address within the city at least thirty
6. days before the city election at which the person seeks to vote; and
7. is not disqualified under Alaska Constitution, Art. V.

ABSENTEE VOTING:

If you will be absent from the city during the election period, you may request that an absentee by-mail ballot be mailed to you up to ten calendar days prior to the election. Applications for an absentee by-mail ballots may be obtained on the City's website at www.cityofbethel.org or at the City Clerk's office, located at 300 State Highway, Bethel during regular business hours.

Absentee in person voting will be offered at the City Clerk's Office, 300 State Highway, Bethel, from 9:00 a.m. – 12:30p.m. and 1:30p.m.-4:30p.m. beginning on September 19, 2016 and continuing through October 3, 2016.

VOTING ASSISTANCE INFORMATION:

Special needs' voting is available through Election Day. Please contact the City Clerk at 543-1384 for more information.

If you require special assistance due to a disability or bilingual need, please contact the City Clerk's office at 543-1384 24-hours prior to the time of casting your ballot.
