VII. TRANSPORTATION INSPECTOR REPORT

KaJena Baty- *See Chief's Monthly Report for Transportation Inspector Activity.*
The police are having a zero tolerance when dealing with cabs because we need to address the complaints made. Cab complaints may be handled criminally and/or administratively. Citations are issued by police officers to gain voluntary compliance with the law, citations are issued at the officer's discretion. If the transportation inspector determines that the chauffeur is unable to safely operate a vehicle and may be a danger to the public then a complaint may also be handled administratively by a temporary suspension or revocation of the driver's chauffeur license.





May 2013 Monthly Report

Personnel:

Aaron Fedolfi was transferred to the CSO position after Manny Bobbio, our injured CSO decided to take a position with DOC in New Mexico after he recovered from his injuries.

Justin Ulak who was hired as a Community Service Patrol Officer (Temp) was transferred to full time and is doing well in his training program for CSP.

Jeffrey McDaniel was unable to continue employment with BPD due to personal reasons and he returned to Texas.

We have 4 officer candidates in the final selection and testing process.

Operations (Patrol / Communications):

During this reported period the Bethel Police Department Dispatch Center (Communications) logged 959 calls for service, over two hundred calls more than last month

Of the 959 calls for service the police departments investigated this month, 135 required case reports, of which 103 were closed by arrest or other means.

Department Activity for the month included:

- 16 Assaults
- 4 Burglaries
- 8 DUI
- 7 Liquor law violations
- 5 Stolen vehicles
- 11 Traffic Accidents, 3 resulting in injury

Animal Control:

The Bethel Police Department impounded 6 animals during this reporting period (May), of which includes 6 dogs and 0 cats.

The following are the disposition of the animals in the pound:

- numerous Released to Bethel Friends of K9
- 2 Dogs still impounded
- 0 Quarantine (from May '13)

Administration:

KaJena Baty completed numerous Taxi Cab vehicle inspections, vehicle permit renewals, Taxi Cab vehicle transfers, Chauffer permits, and Chauffer permit renewals. No cab complaints listed. Cab business complaints involved the investigation of radio violations by another cab company.

Community Service Patrol:

CSP for this reporting period handled 108 individuals, of which 79 were males and 29 were females. Of the 108 persons contacted by the CSP, 14 were placed at YKCC, 79 Sobering Center, 4 were placed at the hospital, 11 were accepted by a private person / residence and none were able to care for themselves.





Sec. 03.55.010. Killing of vicious or mad dog authorized. Any person may lawfully kill any vicious or mad dog running at large.

Sec. 03.55.020. Dogs deemed vicious. Any dog which when unprovoked has ever bitten or attacked a human being is considered vicious within the meaning of AS 03.55.010.

Sec. 03.55.030. Killing dogs annoying or evincing tendency to bite animals or fowls. Whenever any dog habitually annoys or attacks wild deer, reindeer, sheep, cattle, horse, or other animal or kills either domestic or wild, or evinces a disposition which makes it likely that it will without provocation bite an animal or injure any person, the owner or keeper of the dog, if known or reasonably identifiable, shall be notified and given reasonable opportunity to restrain the dog before it is lawful to kill it. Persons authorized to enforce AS 03.55.010 (Alaska Fish and Game Code) and peace officers may enforce this section.

Sec. 03.55.040. - 03.55.060 Dog control by government units. [Repealed, Sec. 9 ch 109 SLA 1966]. Repealed or F-numbered

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Sec. 03.55.100. Minimum standards of care for animals. (a) The minimum standards of care for animals include

- (1) food and water sufficient to maintain each animal in good health;
- (2) an environment compatible with protecting and maintaining the good health and safety of the animal; and
- (3) reasonable medical care at times and to the extent available and necessary to maintain the animal in good health.

(b) Any determination as to whether or not the standards of this chapter are met shall be based on the professional opinion of a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98.

(c) The department may adopt regulations to implement this section.

Sec. 03.55.110. Investigation of cruelty to animals complaints.

(a) A person who believes that cruelty to animals has taken place or is taking place may file a complaint with a public or private animal control agency or organization, the department, or a peace officer. An agency or organization or the department may refer the complaint to a peace officer.

(b) A peace officer who receives a complaint of animal cruelty may apply for a search warrant under AS 12.35 to the judicial officer in the judicial district in which the alleged violation has taken place or is taking place. If the court finds that probable cause exists, the court shall issue a search warrant directing a peace officer to proceed immediately to the location of the alleged violation, search the place designated in the warrant, and, if warranted, take property, including animals, specified in the warrant. The warrant shall be executed by the peace officer and returned to the court.

(c) Before a peace officer may take an animal and place it into protective custody, the peace officer shall request an immediate inspection and decision by a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98 that placement into protective custody is in the immediate best interest of the animal. If a veterinarian is not available to perform an inspection, before a peace officer may take an animal, the peace officer shall communicate with a veterinarian who has, after hearing a description of the condition of the animal and its environment, decided it is in the immediate best interest of the animal that it be placed into protective custody. If the peace officer is not able to communicate with a veterinarian, before the officer may take an animal, the officer shall decide it is in the immediate best interest of the animal that it be placed into protective custody. For purposes of this section, "peace officer" means

- (1) an officer of the state troopers;
- (2) a member of the police force of a municipality;
- (3) a village public safety officer; or
- (4) a regional public safety officer.

Sec. 03.55.120. Seizure of animals. (a) A peace officer shall place an animal in protective custody before removing the animal from the location where it was found. If the animal is removed, the peace officer shall place the animal with a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98 or, if a veterinarian is not readily available, with a responsible public or private custodian to be sheltered, cared for, and provided necessary medical attention.

(b) A peace officer who has removed an animal shall immediately notify the animal's owner in writing of the removal and of the

owner's right to petition the court under AS 03.55.130 for return of the animal. Notification may be delivered in person, posted at the owner's residence, or mailed to the owner.

(c) If a removed animal's owner is unknown and cannot be ascertained with reasonable effort, the animal shall be considered a stray or abandoned.

(d) The state, a municipality, or a person, that supplies shelter, care, veterinary attention, or medical treatment for an animal seized under this section shall make a reasonable effort to locate the owner.

Sec. 03.55.130. Destruction and adoption of animals. (a) If a determination is made by a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98, by a peace officer in consultation with a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98, or by a peace officer who is unable to locate or communicate with a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98 that an animal removed under AS 03.55.100 - 03.55.190 is injured or diseased to such an extent that, in the opinion of the veterinarian, it is probable the animal cannot recover, the veterinarian or the peace officer may humanely destroy the animal or arrange for the animal's humane destruction.

(b) Upon diagnosis and recommendation of a veterinarian licensed under AS 08.98, a public or private custodian may humanely destroy or arrange for the humane destruction of a severely injured, diseased, or suffering animal that has been removed under AS 03.55.100 - 03.55.190.

(c) An owner of an animal destroyed under this section may not recover damages for the destruction of the animal unless the owner shows that the destruction was not reasonable under the facts as known to the veterinarian or the peace officer authorizing the destruction.

(d) Except as provided in (a) or (b) of this section, the custodian of an animal may not adopt, provide for the adoption of, or euthanize the animal within 10 business days after the animal is taken into custody. An owner may prevent the animal's adoption or destruction by

(1) petitioning the court of the judicial district in which the animal was removed for the animal's immediate return, subject, if appropriate, to court-imposed conditions; or

(2) posting a bond or security with the court of the judicial district in which the animal was seized in an amount determined by the court to be sufficient to provide for the animal's care for a minimum of 30 days from the date the animal was removed.

(e) If the custodian still has custody of the animal when the bond or security posted under (d)(2) of this section expires and the court has not ordered an alternative disposition, the animal becomes the custodian's property. If a court order prevents the custodian from assuming ownership and the custodian continues to care for the animal, the court shall require the owner of the animal to pay by bond or otherwise for the custodian's continuing costs of care for the animal until a final disposition of the animal is made by the court.

(f) The state may not be required to reimburse a public or private agency, organization, or person that voluntarily assists with a removal of an animal or receives custody of an animal removed under this section for costs of shelter, care, veterinary assistance, or medical treatment rendered to the animal.

Sec. 03.55.190. Definitions. In AS 03.55.100 - 03.55

- (1) "animal" has the meaning given in AS 11.000;
- (2) "custodian" means a person responsible for the law for the care, custody, or control of animals;
- (3) "department" means the Department of Environmental Conservation.

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Sec. 11.61.140. Cruelty to animals. (a) A person commits cruelty to animals if the person

(1) knowingly inflicts severe and prolonged physical pain or suffering on an animal;

(2) with criminal negligence, fails to care for an animal and, as a result, causes the death of the animal or causes severe physical pain or prolonged suffering to the animal;

(3) kills or injures an animal by the use of a decompression chamber;

(4) intentionally kills or injures a pet or livestock by the use of poison;

(5) knowingly kills or injures an animal, other than as provided in (1) or (3) of this subsection, with the intent to intimidate, threaten, or terrorize another person;

(6) knowingly

(A) engages in sexual conduct with an animal; or

(B) under circumstances not proscribed under AS

11.41.455,

(i) photographs or films, for purposes of sexual gratification, a person engaged in sexual conduct with an animal; or

(ii) causes, induces, aids, or encourages another person to engage in sexual conduct with an animal; or

(7) intentionally permits sexual conduct with an animal to be conducted on any premises under the person's control.

(b) Each animal that is subject to cruelty to animals under (a) of this section shall constitute a separate offense.

(c) It is a defense to a prosecution under this section that the conduct of the defendant

(1) was part of scientific research governed by accepted standards;

(2) constituted the humane destruction of an animal;

(3) conformed to accepted veterinary or animal husbandry practices;

(4) was necessarily incidental to lawful fishing, hunting or trapping activities;

(5) conformed to professionally accepted training and discipline standards.

(d) In (a)(2) of this section, failure to provide the minimum standards of care for an animal under AS 03.55.100 is prima facie evidence of failure to care for an animal.

(e) This section does not apply to generally accepted dog mushing or pulling contests or practices or rodeos or stock contests.

(f) In this section, "sexual conduct" means any

(1) touching or fondling by a person, either directly or through clothing, of the genitals or anus of an animal or any transfer or transmission of semen by the person on any part of the animal for the purpose of sexual gratification or arousal of the person;

(2) contact, however slight, between the mouth, genitals, or anus of a person and the sex organ or anus of an animal, or any intrusion, however slight, of any part of the body of the person into the sex organ or anus of an animal, or any intrusion of the genitals or anus of the person into the mouth of the animal for the purpose of sexual gratification of the person.

(g) Except as provided in (h) of this section, cruelty to animals under (a)(2), (5), (6), or (7) of this section is a class A

misdemeanor. The court may also

(1) require forfeiture of any animal affected or to a custodian that supplies shelter, care, or medical treatment for the animal;

(2) require the defendant to reimburse the custodian for all reasonable costs incurred in providing shelter, care, veterinary attention, or medical treatment for any animal affected;

(3) prohibit or limit the defendant's ownership, possession, or custody of animals for up to 10 years

(h) Cruelty to animals under (a)(1), (3), or (4) is a class C felony. Cruelty to animals is also a class C felony if the person is convicted under (a)(2), (5), (6), or (7) of this section and the person has been previously convicted on one or more separate occasions within 10 years of the date of the offense of a crime under this section, AS 11.61.145, or a law or ordinance of another jurisdiction having provisions similar to those offenses. For a conviction under this subsection, the court may also

(1) require forfeiture of any animal affected or to a custodian that supplies shelter, care, or medical treatment for the animal;

(2) require the defendant to reimburse the custodian for all reasonable costs incurred in providing shelter, care, veterinary attention, or medical treatment for any animal affected;

(3) prohibit or limit the defendant's ownership, possession, or custody of animals for up to 10 years

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Related Bethel Municipal Codes:

6.04.010 Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

A. "Animal" means all domestic or domesticated members of the animal kingdom, classes Mammalia and Aves.

B. "Animal control agent" means a salaried city employee under the direction of the chief of police who shall be responsible for the licensing of animals, rabies control of impounded animals, investigation of animal bites and complaints, maintaining the animal control program and the city animal impoundment center, and the destruction and disposal of unwanted animals. The animal control agent may participate in public education efforts concerning animal control and safety.

C. "Animal control shelter" means a city-maintained impoundment with pens for dogs and other animals.

D. "Cat" means any domestic member of the family Felidae, commonly referred to as a cat.

E. "Dog" means any member of the mammalia family Canidae commonly called dogs, but not fox, wolf or other game species the taking of which is regulated by the state. Any game species kept as a pet must have a valid state permit.

F. "Kennel" means a premises or property where four (4) or more dogs six (6) months of age or older are kept.

G. "Frequent or prolonged noise" means:

1. Repeated vocalizing by any animal(s), except an animal in a licensed kennel or a commercial facility for animals, in a sixty- (60-) minute period from the time the noise begins and that lasts for more than twenty (20) consecutive minutes between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.;

2. Repeated vocalizing by any animal(s) for ten (10) consecutive minutes between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Amd. 1 to Ord. 177, 1988; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.020 Care and restraint of dogs.

A. All dogs located outside the confines of their owners' or keepers' property shall be restrained at a safe distance from public streets, public walkways and public parks and playgrounds. All dogs shall be securely restrained by means of a chain, harness or leash, except in an established dog park (BMC 6.04.100) where said dog is accompanied by owner and under voice control. No dog may run at large within the city limits. No person having charge or control of said animal may permit the animal to run at large within the city.

B. All dogs shall be cared for in a safe and sanitary manner. Shelter shall be provided as needed. All owners or keepers shall provide for adequate care and feeding of the animals. Failure to provide for

adequate caring and feeding of the animals will result in a citation being issued and owner or keeper subject to a fine and possible impoundment of the dog.

C. An owner shall prevent the dog from engaging in the following activities: barking, whining or howling in excessive, continuous or untimely fashion, to keep or permit the same to disturb a neighborhood or any number of persons by frequent or prolonged noise.

Upon receipt of a written statement identifying dates and time periods of frequent and prolonged noise signed by one or more persons residing at different physical addresses in the immediate vicinity of the noise by the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee, the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee shall investigate and if warranted order the owner of the animal to immediately comply with this subsection.

All orders issued under this subsection may contain:

1. The definition of "frequent or prolonged noise";
2. A copy of this chapter;
3. The nature and the times of the noise as identified in the written statement;
4. Potential methods of curtailing animal noise;
5. The amount of time allowed to comply with the notice.

If the owner fails to comply with any order issued pursuant to this subsection, an animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee may issue the owner a citation for violation of this chapter, and remove the animal that was making the noise to the animal control shelter.

D. A person who fails to comply with this section for care and maintenance of dogs shall be subject to all penalties established under BMC [6.04.090](#). [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 93-35 § 4; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.030 Animals at large.

Any loose dogs or other animals not under the immediate supervision of the owner or his agent, or found unsupervised, leashed or unleashed, within the city limits on public streets, walkways, rights-of-way, public parks and playgrounds, or otherwise outside the property of the owner or agent may be captured by the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee and be impounded. [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.040 Animal control shelter.

The city shall maintain an animal control shelter under the direction of the chief of police. [Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.045 Vaccination against rabies.

All dogs and cats shall be vaccinated against rabies from age three (3) months on. [Amd. 1 to Ord. 177, 1988; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.050 Dog licensing.

A city dog license shall be required for all dogs six (6) months of age or older. The license shall expire on December thirty-first (31st) of each year for the non-computer-chip license. The implanted computer chip license shall be valid for the life of the dog. A valid rabies immunization certificate shall be required before the dog license will be issued. The fee for licensing shall be established and may be periodically adjusted by noncode ordinance. [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 01-09 § 5; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.060 Dog kennel.

A. All kennels within the city shall be licensed. Application for a kennel license shall be made to the animal control officer. The application for a kennel license shall contain the following information:

1. The name and address of the applicant;
2. The number and breed(s) of dogs to be kept at kennel;
3. Proof of a current rabies vaccination for each dog kept at the facility.

B. All dogs shall be maintained in a safe and sanitary manner. All kennel owners or keepers shall provide for the adequate care and feeding of the animals within the kennel. Failure to properly maintain a kennel or to provide adequate care or feeding of the animals within a kennel will result in a citation being issued and the owner or keeper subject to a fine and possible revocation of the kennel license.

C. A kennel license shall be issued for one (1) calendar year. All kennel licenses shall expire on December thirty-first (31st) of each year. An application for renewal of the kennel license shall be on a form provided by the animal control office. Kennel fees shall be four (4) times the costs of a single license fee.

D. A person who fails to comply with the provisions of this section for licensing and maintenance of kennels shall be subject to all penalties established under BMC [6.04.090](#). [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.070 Impoundment.

A. Any animal impounded within the city animal control shelter shall be held a minimum of four (4) days including Saturday, Sunday and holidays, during which the pound is open at least two (2) hours.

B. Any impounded animal suspected of having rabies or that has unprovokingly bitten a person shall be impounded in isolation for a minimum of ten (10) days. An animal impounded for the second (2nd) time for biting a person unprovoked shall be destroyed after the ten- (10-) day holding period.

C. Any animal not released after the four- (4-) day impoundment holding period may be destroyed or disposed of at the discretion of the animal control officer.

D. The city council shall establish and may periodically adjust an impoundment fee schedule and a destruction fee by noncode ordinance.

E. No animal shall be released from the animal control shelter until all licensing, impoundment, vaccination and adoption fees are paid.

F. Any person adopting an animal from the animal control shelter shall pay any and all impoundment and vaccination fees in addition to an adoption fee as set by the city council. [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 01-09 § 6; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.080 Emergency animal control.

A. Whenever there exists a substantial problem of unconfined and free-roaming dogs and this problem shall be of such nature as to exceed the ability of the animal control officer to safely and adequately deal with such loose dogs, the city council may declare an emergency dog control program into effect. In determining whether an emergency program shall be declared, the city council shall consider:

1. The number of citizen complaints;
2. The nature of citizen complaints;
3. The existence of reported rabies cases or other contagious diseases carried by dogs;
4. The ability of the city dog pound to safely care for additional animals;
5. Other relevant factors.

B. If an emergency dog control program is declared, such emergency program shall be announced by posting notice in at least three (3) places within the city, by announcing such program at least once daily on local radio or television, and by noticing such program in a newspaper of local circulation at least once.

C. At the conclusion of seven (7) days after such announcement has first (1st) been noticed, the city council may order the destruction of free-roaming dogs by specified public safety personnel and/or the animal control officer. Such emergency control program shall be in effect for no more than thirty (30) days, and may be extended only by resolution of the council, after public hearing. [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 177, 1987.]

6.04.085 Immediate destruction.

A. If after diligent effort the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee is unable to capture an at-large animal, whether licensed or unlicensed, and if said animal shows signs of aggression toward the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee, and/or citizen in the community, sufficient to place said agent, chief of police, designee and/or citizen in reasonable apprehension of bodily injury, the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee may immediately destroy the animal. If such destroyed animal is found to be licensed, the owner shall be promptly notified.

B. Any person wishing to have his animal(s) destroyed by the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee may do so upon payment of fees regulated in the BMC ordinance of fees and charges, accompanied by a waiver to relinquish said animal to the city of Bethel and Bethel police department.

C. Upon delivery of a dog to the animal control shelter when no additional facilities exist for the confining of more animals, the animal control agent and/or chief of police and/or designee may destroy summarily whichever dog has been confined at the animal control shelter for the longest period of time, for purposes of providing a place to confine the newly captured dog. Said summary destruction shall occur notwithstanding the provisions of BMC 6.04.070(A) otherwise allowing four days for redemption.

D. Reasonable efforts to notify the owner(s) of a licensed animal will be made prior to destroying said animal. [Ord. 11-12 § 2.]

6.04.090 Penalties.

A. A person who fails to comply with the provisions of this chapter may be issued a citation for ordinance violation by the animal control officer. The citation shall impose a penalty of fifty dollars (\$50) for the first (1st) violation, one hundred dollars (\$100) for the second (2nd) violation, and two hundred dollars (\$200) for each succeeding violation within ninety (90) days.

B. Each working day that an animal is kept in violation of a citation issued under this chapter shall constitute a separate violation.

C. The city may seek injunctive relief to enforce compliance with this chapter.

D. It is a violation of this chapter for any person or persons to open a vehicle being used to transport dogs or other animals to the city dog pound or the doors of the city dog pound with the intent of allowing impounded dogs or other animals to escape. Such person or persons upon conviction shall be subject to the penalty established in Chapter 1.08 BMC. [Ord. 11-12 § 2; Ord. 93-35 § 4; Ord. 177, 1987.]

Chapter 9.24 WEAPONS

Sections:

[9.24.010](#) Discharge – Aiming at person – Carrying concealed.

[9.24.020](#) Prohibition posted – Definitions.

9.24.010 Discharge – Aiming at person – Carrying concealed.

Except as reasonably necessary to protect life or property, it is unlawful for any person in the city to:

- A. Discharge any firearm or air rifle except in areas designated by the city manager; or
- B. Intentionally point or aim a firearm, air rifle, or other dangerous weapon, loaded or otherwise at any person; or
- C. Carry a firearm, air rifle or a deadly weapon in any restricted access area of municipal government buildings. [Ord. 06-06 §§ 2, 3; Ord. 95-36 § 3; Ord. 183, 1988; prior code § 8.12.010.]

9.24.020 Prohibition posted – Definitions.

A. All restricted access areas of municipal government buildings in which the possession of firearms is prohibited shall have posted the notice of prohibition against possession of firearms at each entrance.

B. For purposes of this chapter:

- 1. "Firearms" includes firearms, or any other element relating to firearms or parts thereof including ammunition and reloading components.
- 2. "Restricted access area" means the area beyond a secure point where visitors are screened and does not include common areas of ingress and egress open to the general public. [Ord. 06-06 § 3.]
