



September 2013 Monthly Report

Personnel:

Vincent Bryant has arrived and begun his FTO program.

Nichole Elarton is progressing satisfactorily in the Fairbanks police academy and has completed the Taser, shotgun and Criminal Law to date in addition to the normal studies and daily physical fitness training. The recruits attend classes evenings and Saturday and Sunday except for one weekend per month.

Alisha Chaglauk, from Toksook Bay, has completed her final testing and will begin her career as a police officer here in Bethel within the following weeks. Alisha put herself through the criminal justice program and graduated the last police academy in Fairbanks. We look forward to having Alisha on board and thank Nichole who assisted us in the final interview and testing process in addition to her school duties since Alisha was in Fairbanks.

We still have an open officer position which we have two candidates for this position, one in the testing phase and one CSP opening.

Officer Cox is set for the refresher academy located at Sitka in January.

Operations (Patrol / Communications):

We are still awaiting final completion of Salmonberry and will hopefully have another open house when the contractor and other remaining items are completed.

During this reported period the Bethel Police Department Dispatch Center (Communications) logged 848 calls for service for BPD of which 108 required case reports, of those 68 (76%) were closed by arrest or other means. 44 adult arrests with 1 juvenile arrests.

Department Activity for the month included:

- 18 Assaults- 11 cleared by arrest
- 1 Burglaries
- 6 DUI
- 3 Liquor law violations

- 3 Stolen vehicles
- 6 Traffic Accidents, 3 injury, 0 resulting in death
- 7 Trespass Violations
- 14 Damaged Property

Animal Control:

The Bethel Police Department impounded 23 animals during this reporting period of which includes 22 dogs and 1 cats.

The following are the disposition of the animals in the pound:

- 11 Returned to owner
- 10 Released to Bethel Friends of K9
- 2 Dogs still impounded
- 1 Quarantine (released to owner, check negative)
- 0 Euthanized
- 5 Cited

Administration:

Kajena handled 6 inspections, 2 chauffeur renewals, 0 vehicle permit renewals, 4 vehicle transfers, 0 revocations and 0 temporary permits, 1 new chauffeur, 2 chauffeur renewal. Four taxi citizen complaints were investigated. Jena was assigned dispatch duties due to vacation coverage for the majority of the month.

Community Service Patrol:

CSP for this reporting period handled 88 individuals, of which 56 were males and 32 were females. Of the 88 persons contacted by the CSP, 21 were placed at YKCC, 55 Sobering Center, 3 were placed at the hospital, 7 were accepted by a private person / residence and 2 were able to care for themselves. 30 were residents and 58 were nonresidents. August-159, July-147

These numbers do not reflect Title 47 inebriates handled by patrol or the CSO.



Ordinance #13-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 5.40 CHAUFFEURS, CELL PHONE USE PROHIBITED

WHEREAS, operating a motor vehicle is a multi-task function and dispatching via radio and telephone complicates and distracts from the safe and professional operation of a "for hire" commercial vehicle.

WHEREAS, using a cell-phone while operating a taxicab has proven to be distracting to chauffeurs and therefore dangerous to the public.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska and the US Department of Transportation have enacted rules and regulations regarding cell phones and other devices which distract drivers in an effort to promote traffic safety for commercial drivers and the public.

WHEREAS, prohibiting the use of cell-phones by chauffeurs would increase safe driving practices and prevent dangerous driving action.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of permanent nature and shall be codified within the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 5.40 of the Bethel Municipal Code Chauffeurs is amended as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out).

CHAPTER 5.40 CHAUFFEURS

5.40.110 Two-way radio prohibited.

No chauffeur may possess in a taxicab or allow another to operate a scanner capable of monitoring a frequency used by a dispatch service other than that used by the taxicab's dispatch service.

5.40.120 Records. Cell-phone use prohibited.

- A. ~~Repealed by Ord. 07-16.~~ A chauffeur may not operate a regulated vehicle while using a cell-phone unless the chauffeur is using his or her cell-phone to report illegal activity, summon medical or other emergency help, prevent injury to a person or property, or when parked without any passengers in the vehicle.

- B. A chauffeur operating a permitted vehicle while holding a cell-phone to his or her ear is guilty of violating this subsection of the BMC.
1. A written warning to be added to the Chauffeur's file for the first (1st) offense.
 2. Suspension of Chauffeur's permit for a minimum of (10) days for the second (2nd) offense.
 3. Chauffeur's permit is susceptible to revocation for the third (3rd) offense.

5.40.130 Requirement of check-in and check-out.

Each chauffeur of a taxicab must check in with the dispatch service engaged by the permittee when the chauffeur begins a work shift and check out when the chauffeur departs a work shift.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately, upon passage by the City Council.
