REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

April 27, 1970

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Swanson. Roll was called.
Present: Jack Baxter, Bruce Crow, Eddie Hoffman, Kevin Murphy, Gene Peltola.
Absent: Robert Nick.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

COMMUNICATIONS: Snodgrass read the following letters: 1) from the Dept. of Highways regarding the proposed bridge across Brown Slough; 2) a postcard from EDA stating that Bethel's OEDP report had been received and was being reviewed; 3) from the ABC Board regarding the City's protest of the Anderson-Mendola liquor license; 4) a copy letter from Samuelson Flying Service to the Dept. of Transportation, FAA, protesting the location of radio tower. Swanson read a letter from IRS regarding the case with Bethel Sales, Inc.

M/M Crow, Baxter that HEARING ON BRIDGE, PROPOSED TOWER LOCATION, and INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE LEVY AGAINST BETHEL SALES, INC. be placed at the end of this agenda. Unanimous.

INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE LEVY AGAINST BETHEL SALES, INC.:

The city administrator was instructed to attempt to get an estimate of the cost of appealing the case.

RADIO STATION TOWER:

City Administrator was instructed to call Mr. Northrip about changing the radio station tower site.

BROWN SLOUGH BRIDGE:

M/M Crow, Baxter that the council go on record as requesting the State Dept. of Highways to hold a public hearing on proposed bridge. Unanimous.
