RESOLUTION # 03-27

A Resolution requesting Capital Funding through the State of Alaska, Village Safe Water Program, SFY2005 Capital Construction Questionnaire

WHEREAS, The Bethel Council, hereinafter called the Council, is the governing body of the City of Bethel, Alaska, and;

WHEREAS, The Council desires to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of Bethel, Alaska and has determined the project to be number one priority for the community, and;

WHEREAS, The Department of Environmental Conservation/Village Safe Water Program, hereinafter, called VSW, can provide the technical assistance necessary to improve the sanitation facilities' problem,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council hereby requests the Governor and Legislature to appropriate \$3,000,000 included in SFY2005 Capital Construction Questionnaire through the VSW Program to design and build the Bethel Water and Sewer Improvements (Service construction management and administrative services for the Service Area 1B water and sewer improvements identified as part of the Phase 1 improvements in the City of Bethel Water and Sewer Facilities Master Plan Update, dated July 2, 1996).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council hereby authorizes VSW or its representatives to enter upon or cross community land for the purposes of assisting the Council in carrying out this sanitation facilities' improvement project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council will cooperate with the provisions of needed agreements entered into between the Council and VSW, and that said provisions will be duly carried out by City of Bethel's Administration.


