DISPOSAL OF CITY-OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has numerous "sticks" of Arctic pipe and fittings considered to be surplus, no longer needed for municipal purposes, and valued at more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00);


WHEREAS, the village of Akiachak is in need of Arctic pipe and fittings to enable a State of Alaska project contracted to Phillips & Jordan Construction to proceed expeditiously;

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council, by this resolution, has determined that the City's surplus Arctic pipe and fittings can be disposed of in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 4-10, Sections A5 and B of the Bethel Municipal Code (BMC);

WHEREAS, Phillips and Jordan Construction has agreed to purchase twelve (12) "sticks" of Arctic 3-inch dual service pipe (480 linear feet) at \$45.00 a linear foot, eight (8) Arctic 3-inch dual service elbows at \$800.00 each, and four (4) Arctic 3-inch dual service tees at \$1,200.00 each for a total purchase price of thirty two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$32,800.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council authorizes the City Manager to dispose of the property identified herein in accordance with the provisions set forth.

ENACTED THIS 19th DAY OF OCTOBER 2009 BY A VOTE OF 7 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
