Alexie, Andrew. Motion passed.

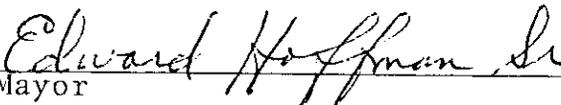
Item H. Paul Gregory - B.N.C.

Abstain: Hoffman, Andrew. Motion passed.

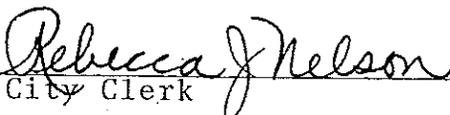
M/M Guinn that part of Museum's craft money be used for traveling
