ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.44.070  
AND SECTION 2.44.090 OF THE BETHEL CITY  
CODE RELATING TO SPECIAL ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
BETHEL, ALASKA, that:

Section 1. Section 2.44.070 of the Bethel Code of  
Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.44.070 Special Elections

Special elections may be called by the Council.  
No special elections may be called within ninety (90) days  
of the general election, unless the special election is held  
at the same time as the general election.

Section 2. Section 2.44.090 of the Bethel Code of  
Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.44.090 Election - Notice

It shall be the duty of the Clerk of the City of  
Bethel to publish or post in three (3) public places in said  
city at least fifteen (15) days before any general election,  
and at least twenty (20) days before any special election, a  
notice of such election. The notice of election shall  
include, but not be limited to, the date of the election,  
precinct descriptions, polling place locations, poll hours,  
elector qualifications, and the offices and propositions to  
appear on the ballot.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect  
immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
