

An Ordinance Listing Certain Misdemeanors as unlawful in the City of Bethel, Providing Penalties for Violation, and Fixing an Effective Date.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska:

It shall be unlawful for any person in the City of Bethel, Alaska, to:

Section 1 Carry, Conceal, or transport an open bottle of intoxicating liquor, wine or beer, such open bottle being defined as a bottle or can which has a broken seal or which is in some other way obviously open, on any person in a public place, or in an automobile, or on a boat of less than 30' in length, or on a snowmobile or any other vehicle used for transport of persons, while said person is under the influence of an intoxicant.

VIOLATION:

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not to exceed \$100.00 or be imprisoned for any period not to exceed 10 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall become effective the day following its final passage and approval.
