RESOLUTION #97-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A COORDINATED CLIENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Adult Day Care (ADC) Program of the City's Community Services Department serves a low-income, mobility-impaired clientele; and

WHEREAS, the Adult Day Care Program is in need of a reliable, cost-effective means of transportation for their clients; and

WHEREAS, the bus previously used for transportation of ADC clients can no longer be repaired for continued safe use; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority's Coordinated Client Transportation Services Program, administered by the State DOT&PF, is intended to increase the mobility of beneficiaries of the Trust by promoting the development of coordinated transportation within their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Adult Day Care Program would like to apply for a grant from the Coordinated Client Transportation Service Program to purchase a new bus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL that it hereby authorizes submission of the application for the Coordinated Client Transportation Services Program grant, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the grant documents.
