APPROVAL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL-BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM, DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY AND DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and Orutsararmiut Native Council are collaborating to initiate, operate, and maintain a public transit system in Bethel;

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requires public transit systems, like the Bethel Public Transit System, to have an approved set of drug and alcohol policies;


WHEREAS, approving the transit set of drug and alcohol policies and drug and alcohol testing procedures will require the City of Bethel to adhere to those policies and maintain confidential records and documents;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel followed the advice of the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, Transit Office, when it created the new set of drug and alcohol policies for the Bethel Public Transit System that are separate and distinct from the City's current drug and alcohol policies;

WHEREAS, in order to expedite the initiation of public transit service, City Manager Foley approved and signed the 36-page *City of Bethel – Bethel Transit System, Drug and Alcohol Policy and Drug and Alcohol Testing Procedures* as a precursor to Bethel City Council approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council approves and adopts the City of Bethel – Bethel Transit System, Drug and Alcohol Policy and Drug and Alcohol Testing Procedures as the one set of FTA-approved drug and alcohol policies for the Bethel Public Transit System;

ENACTED THIS 13th DAY OF JANUARY 2009 BY A VOTE OF 7 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
