LICENSE ID# - 4963**


WHEREAS, based on the advisory votes cast at the January 19, 2010 City of Bethel, Special Election the citizens of Bethel voted in opposition to the issuance of all types of alcohol licensing within the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, there have been many complaints brought to the Public Safety and Transportation Commission on the facilities traffic and pedestrian issues at their nightly bingo games, alcohol would increase those problems;

WHEREAS, parking would be an increased concern with the facility if alcohol were to become available;


