A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MITIGATION MEASURES AND ADHERE TO ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel "City" will comply with conditions set forth by the USDA/RD Office in order to obtain grant-related approval for water and sewer infrastructure development;

WHEREAS, the City will pursue actions negotiated with environmental regulatory officials to avoid or minimize adverse environmental impacts;


WHEREAS, the City will pursue actions that are required for successful implementation of the QFC#2 Forcemain Improvements project in design, construction and operation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council hereby supports the following mitigation measures to ensure consistency with environmental requirements:

- 1.) All work done within the floodplain will need to be elevated above the floodplain and/or flood proofed and permitted by the City of Bethel.
- 2.) Wetland conversions must be minimized and mitigated.
