## *CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA*

### **Resolution # 10-45**

#### **ACCEPT AND APPROVE THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,867 TO PURCHASE ONE TIDE GAUGE, ONE WEATHER STATION, AND TWO ALL-HAZARD RADIOS FOR USE BY THE PORT OF BETHEL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel was awarded a grant from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$7,867 to purchase one tide gauge, one weather station, and two all-hazard radios for use by the Port of Bethel;

**WHEREAS**, the equipment will allow the Port of Bethel to obtain meteorological data specific to the Kuskokwim River and Bethel Area, upload the data to a computer database, and relay this data via radio to boat captains and other interested parties;

**WHEREAS**, the National Weather Service strongly supports the Port's intended use of a tide gauge and wants access to the data collected;

**WHEREAS**, one all-hazard radio will be stationed outside at the Bethel Small Boat Harbor so that boaters can use it to get the latest weather forecast and National Weather Service alerts before disembarking on the river;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council accepts and approves the Hazard Mitigation Grant from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$7,867 to purchase one tide gauge, one weather station, and two all-hazard radios for use by the Port of Bethel.
