Jimmy Hoffman presented his proposal i.e. that a corporation similar to Kotzabue be set up in Bethel, to sell liquor. With all profits to be turned over to the City Council to be used as they best see fit.

Due to the poor showing of people attending the meeting it was decided that there was no real interest in a corporation at this time. That if there were those interested they should form their corporation, circulate a petition and present it to the Council prior to the general elections in October.
