MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

July 8, 1963

At the National Guard Armory

MMS J. Hoffman/E. Hoffman that the City turn over their interest in the Civil Defense building and try for reimbursement of the \$750.00 moving cost, MC to the Alaska National Guard,

MMS Shantz/E. Hoffman that the Secretary write to Mr. Bell and ask if a mistake had been made in omitting the Notary seal from the deed to lots 10 and 11, or see if is not needed. MC

MMS Shantz/Gamble to purchase 500 lbs of LDT powder on the fall boat. Gamble, J. Hoffman, J. Wise, Shantz, E. Hoffman in favor.

MMS Weise/Gamble that the Council meeting with Don Baker, BIA officials, and Budget shall be held at call of the Chair. MC

The Council is to meet with Don Baker at 1 o'clock on July 12th at Armory, to discuss his problems, and to try to reach a solution.
