ORDINANCE #04- 12

AN ORDINANCE PLACING THE PROPOSITION OF WHETHER TO APPROVE A CITY OPERATED LIQUOR STORE ON THE OCTOBER 5, 2004 BALLOT

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is temporary in nature and shall not be incorporated into the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Election. The City Clerk shall place the following proposition on the October 5, 2004 ballot to be presented to the voters of the City of Bethel:

Proposition

CITY OWNED LIQUOR STORE

Shall the City of Bethel change the local option currently in effect that prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages, and adopt in its place a local option that prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages except on premises operated by the City of Bethel under a package store liquor license? A package store is commonly known as a "liquor store," that has the authority to sell alcoholic beverages to persons on the store premises, or to persons known by the liquor store personnel who make written requests for shipments.
