### **Ordinance #06-29**

#### **AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE CITY PLANNER POSITION CLASSIFICATION AND ELIMINATING UNUSED PERSONNEL TITLES WITHIN TITLE 3 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE.**

**WHEREAS** the Bethel Municipal Code establishes Management Employees position ranges based upon their duties and responsibilities;

**WHEREAS** there are currently three positions which have been eliminated;

**WHEREAS** the City Planner has significantly more duties and responsibilities than Range I employees;

**WHEREAS** the City Planner position should be in Range III.

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

**SECTION 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

**SECTION 2. Modification to Bethel Municipal Code Chapter 3.12.070** This ordinance shall become a modification to section 3.17.070 of the Bethel Municipal Code:


