UNFINISHED BUSINESS: RESOLUTION #407, A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PROGRAM REDUCTION WITHIN THE COMMUNITY SERVICE PATROL/DETOX UNIT OF PATC.

City Manager Hoffman reviewed for Council the proposed State budget cuts concerning PATC. The City has met with YKHC and AVCP concerning the operation and possible transfer of the community service patrol to one of the two agencies; discussions concerning this matter are continuing. Administration recommends that protective custody services be made a part of the new jail contract between the State and the City with protective custody located in the present detox unit at PATC. Administration additionally recommended that the City not sign a jail contract with the State for 1984 unless the contract contains provisions addressing protective custody services.

Jack Flood, Director of PATC, addressed Council concerning the cut-back in funding. Mr. Flood spoke in favor of the Resolution before Council.

Councilmember Anvil, Liz Illg (Director of TWC), and Alice Wardlow spoke in favor of retaining the community service patrol.

SLOUGH RIVER PATROL

City Manager Hoffman informed Council that the City is not charging the violator with a point deduction, it is the State that does so for a moving violation. Administration will review the matter with the State patrol.


