AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING THE ADOPTED 07-08 AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AN ANNUAL BUDGETARY ALLOTMENT FOR THE PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A MULTIUSE RECREATION CENTER, 07-10 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 07-08 FOR THE PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF A MULTIUSE RECREATION CENTER AND 09-25 AN ORDINANCE BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING OF THE DESIGNATED BATH CENTER ACCOUNT ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO THE BETHEL AQUATIC TRAINING AND HEALTH CENTER AND STRIKING THE CAP OF FUNDS TO BE ALLOTTED AND THE TWO YEAR APPROPRIATION IN AN INTEREST BEARING ACCOUNT

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and shall not be codified within the Bethel Municipal Code.

Designation of Annual Budgetary Allotment.

- A. The City of Bethel shall designate an allotment of \$500,000 (five hundred thousand dollars) annually for the purpose of construction, operation, and/or maintenance of a multiuse recreation facility to be built within the city limits of Bethel, Alaska.
- B. The \$500,000 (five hundred thousand dollars) must be spent each year or saved in an interest bearing account for up to two years.
- ~~C. That at no time shall the designated interest bearing account accumulate more than \$1,050,000.~~
- D. All funds expended from the designated interest bearing account shall be used for the promotion, construction, operation and maintenance of a City of Bethel Multiuse Recreation Facility.
- E. The City Manager and/or his designee shall be responsible for administering the funds and insuring that the proceeds from said designated interest bearing account are spent for the purposes stated.

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- F. Funds generated from sales tax revenue that are designated for the BATH Center will be appropriated on a monthly basis to the designated interest bearing BATH Center account.
- A. **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** Section 1. F, shall become effective no sooner than 60 days and to later than 90 days after August 25, 2009. With the exception of Section 1. F, this ordinance became effective upon passage of a 1% sales tax increase for 2 years for planning, construction, operation and costs and a .5% sales tax increase for the next 18 years for operation and maintenance costs in the October, 2007 General Election.
