

ORDINANCE #93-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AUTHORIZING A SALE OF CITY PROPERTY NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel published a Notice of Disposal of sale of the Captain Atkins and Dredge; and

WHEREAS, the Captain Atkins and Dredge are described as follows: The Captain Atkins is a steel-hull vessel. *LOA 68' *REG 57.1' *Breadth 20.0' *Depth 5.5 *Powered by 2 c-71 six-cylinder 174 horse power engines *Wheel house and crew quarters consisting of galley, head and 2 two-berth staterooms *Bow ramp operated by hydraulic windless *Blunt raked bow square chine, raked aft bottom fitted with tunnels and Kort type nozzles for twim props and square stern *Hydraulic crane located aft of the port bow with deck house controls.

Dredge: DMI, heavy duty, 10-inch portable cutter suction dredge, model HPC-10EC EconoMaster Series, with standard specifications; components, options and modifications include 1) main dredge pump; 2) main pump drive; 3) diesel power; 4) auxiliary power; 5) hauling and hoisting machinery; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received; and

WHEREAS, highest bid received was submitted by Moody's Sea Lighterage of Anchorage, Alaska, for \$153,000; and

WHEREAS, it is unlikely that the City would receive more than \$153,000 by putting this property out for bids a second time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that the City enter into a sale with Moody's Sea Lighterage in the amount of \$153,000 for the purpose of the sale of surplus City property known as the Captain Atkins and Dredge.
