RESOLUTION #97-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, SUPPORTING A COMMUNITY RECREATION AND MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, we live in a community with many social and economic problems that is challenged by a lack of resources and opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the YK Delta Lifesavers was formed to help create a healthier community by raising funds for the operation and maintenance of a community multi-purpose facility which would incorporate a gymnasium and swimming pool; and

WHEREAS, The YK Delta Lifesavers is a volunteer group which have united as one committee and have joined together as concerned citizens to support a facility which would promote new activities for youth and families in the YK Delta Region; and


WHEREAS, The YK Delta Lifesavers, as a community-oriented organization wish to enhance established youth and family programs, and to create awareness for positive parenting and to identify the need for positive mentors and role models for the youth of the YK Delta Region; and
