A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUCIL SUPPORTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT/PF) IN THEIR EFFORTS TO GAIN FUNDING FOR LOCALLY OWNED AND LOCALLY NOMINATED STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT AND STATE OWNED PORT/HARBOR PROJECTS IN THE BETHEL AREA.

WHEREAS the City of Bethel forwards the projects found in the current Needs List to the nomination process for 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program and other special road projects;

WHEREAS the City of Bethel nominates two new projects, Bethel Port Plane Floating Dock, Ridgecrest Street between Akakeek to Ptarmigan, which the City will be responsible for the maintaining;


WHEREAS the Alaska Department of Transportation is responsible for the long range statewide planning of port and harbor projects;

WHEREAS projects are eligible for federal funding leverage limited state dollars and should therefore be considered as priority projects;
