

RESOLUTION #604

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BETHEL BOARDWALKS PROJECT TO BE PAID FOR BY THE LOCAL SERVICE ROADS AND TRAILS FUND.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to construct a project known as Bethel Boardwalks Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to AS Ch. 84, Sections 19.30.111 through Sections 19.30.241, the State of Alaska has a fund for construction of local service for roads and trails; and

WHEREAS, the City Council request that the State of Alaska proceed with development of the project in the vicinity of Bethel, Alaska, as generally shown on the map attached hereto and made part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project was reviewed and found not to be detrimental to the welfare of the individual natives of this area if the right-of-way should fall within lands withdrawn under Section 11 (2), (1), of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bethel, Alaska have no objections to the granting of a right-of-way by the Bureau of Land Management Townsite Trustee for the above named and numbered project, if applicable; and

WHEREAS, the City Council have no objections to furnishing royalties (permission to use) for materials necessary to construct this project at no cost to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that application be made to the State of Alaska for funds from the Local Service Roads and Trails Fund to be used in construction of the project.
