ORDINANCE 61

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 52 BY REPEALING AND ENACTING SECTION 52-2.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL

Sec 61.1 ENACTING

Section 52-2 of Ordinance 52 is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

Sec 52-2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PERMITS

Every person, including all officers, agents, servants, employees and chauffeurs of any corporation, company, or individual business licensed as provided in this ordinance shall possess the following qualifications:

- (a) Ability to read and write the English language.
- (b) Non-addiction to the use of intoxicants or narcotics.
- (c) Good moral character and repute as determined by arrest records.
- (d) No conviction of a felony for ten years previous to the date of application; no conviction at any time of a felony or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or assault with a deadly weapon or use of or traffic in narcotic drugs or traffic in women for immoral purposes,

In addition to the requirements set forth in this section, all chauffeurs shall possess a current State of Alaska driver's license and be nineteen years of age or older.

The Chief of Police may waive "d" above in the event the applicant has not been involved in any convictions for 12 months prior to application and the Chief feels the applicant has demonstrated a high degree of rehabilitation. In such a case the applicant or permittee is on continuing probation and his permit may be revoked at any time by the Chief of Police or City Manager.
