RESOLUTION NO. 292

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL FUNDS TO PURCHASE \$260,000, FOR SOLID WASTE EQUIPMENT TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature, through HB 60, has approved a Municipal grant for the amount of \$260,000 for a Solid Waste program; and

WHEREAS, the lack of an adequate solid waste program has been a major health concern in the Bethel area, and

WHEREAS, a limited City budget has prevented the purchase of solid waste equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting \$260,000 in Municipal grant funds through the Department of Administration for the purchase of solid waste equipment; and


WHEREAS, Bethel businesses and residents will be better served by a solid waste management program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Administration for the purchase of solid waste equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
