A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

Whereas, The City Council of the City of Bethel wishes to up-grade/renovate the Chief Eddie Hoffman Senior Center to provide community elders with the best possible service, and;

Whereas, The Senior Center is almost 20 years old and is in need of renovation for the safety and needs of its clients and to preserve this 20 year old vital community building, and;

Whereas, The clients of the Senior Center have expressed their support for this project to the Senior Center Director, and;

Whereas, The City of Bethel is an applicant for a grant in the amount of approximately \$293,000 from the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development (hereinafter "Department"), under the CDBG Program for the benefit of the Senior Center, and;

Whereas, The CDBG requires a 100% match, in which 25% must be a cash match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of Bethel hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute any and all documents required for granting and managing funds on behalf of the City of Bethel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Manager is also authorized to execute subsequent amendments to said grant agreement, if awarded to the City of Bethel, to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the Senior Center project.
