RESOLUTION #04-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT THE KASAYULI SUBDIVISION WATER AND SEWER FEASIBILITY STUDY DATED APRIL 2004 AS PRESENTED BY CRW ENGINEERING GROUP, LLC. THIS DOCUMENT CONTAINS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE PHASED CONSTRUCTION OF WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE KASAYULI SUBDIVISION AND IS NEEDED TO REQUEST SANITATION DEFICIENCY FUNDS FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council hereinafter called the City, is the governing body of Bethel, Alaska;

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for the use of Sanitation Deficiency Funds to provide adequate water and sewer facilities for the residents of Kasayuli Subdivision;

WHEREAS, the design duplicates some known design defects in the city subdivision water and sewer project;

WHEREAS, the proposed rate structure does not meet realistic operation and maintenance costs;

WHEREAS, other forms of piped waste retrieval are not adequately and objectively addressed;

WHEREAS, water conservation is not integral to the initial design;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bethel City Council hereby approves and accepts the Kasayuli Subdivision Water and Sewer Feasibility Study, dated April 2004 as presented by CRW Engineering Group, LLC.

Passed and approved this 13th day of April 2004 by a unanimous vote.
