ORDINANCE #05-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4.16.210 B OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE TIME LIMIT TO REQUEST A REFUND ON OVERPAYMENT OF SALES TAX PAID

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 4.16.210 B of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out):


4.16.210 Refund of excess payment.


B. A seller who has made an excess tax payment as set out in subsection A above, shall be given a refund of the excess if the city receives written notice from the seller of the amount claimed as an excess payment accompanied by satisfactory proof of the excess payment in the form required by the finance director. The claim and proof must be received not later than the last day of the ~~third~~ twenty-fourth month following month for which the excess payment was made, without regard to the month during which the payment to the city was actually made.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
