A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT THE FY05 MINI-GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 FOR A MULTIUSE RECREATION FACILITY PLAN

WHEREAS, the need for a multiuse recreation facility has been documented by the community of Bethel as far back as the mid 1970s;

WHEREAS, a first step in the process leading to construction of a multiuse recreation facility is to develop a plan encompassing broad community input;

WHEREAS, the plan would satisfy the need for research into the feasibility of a multiuse recreation facility identified in the Bethel Community Economic Development Strategy Plan's Two-Year Action Plan (May 2003);


WHEREAS, the Application Selection Committee sponsored by the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development approved the City of Bethel's grant proposal to pay consultants to develop a multiuse recreation facility plan;

WHEREAS, three consulting companies provided documentation to support the cost of developing a multiuse recreation facility plan for approximately \$30,000;


WHEREAS, Bethel's FY05 Mini-Grant proposal mentions how the project will "improve the community economy in a significant and long lasting way;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council accepts the FY05 Mini-Grant award of \$30,000 for the development of a multiuse recreation facility plan from the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Community Advocacy, in partnership with the Denali Commission and United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service.
