A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, SUPPORTING THE EDUCATION AND INTELLECTUAL WELL BEING OF ITS CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, it is essential to business, governmental agencies, and non-profit organizations to maintain a central archive of resource information; and

WHEREAS, it is cost prohibitive for any one entity to maintain full library services in a community the size of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel supports the educational services provided by the Kuskokwim Campus of the University of Alaska Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and the Kuskokwim Campus have pooled resources in an ongoing consortium agreement since 1974; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel realizes the significance to the community of the construction of a combined Yup'ik Museum, Library, and Multipurpose Cultural Center; and


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has demonstrated its support for the Yup'ik Museum, Library, and Multipurpose Cultural Center by conceptually approving the conveyance of 30,152 square feet of municipal land and is currently in the process of formally taking action to dispose of this land in accordance with Bethel Municipal Code 4.08.040 Notice of Disposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Bethel will seek to maintain its consortium agreement with the Kuskokwim Campus of the University of Alaska Fairbanks for community library services following the completion of the construction of the Yup'ik Museum, Library, and Multipurpose Cultural Center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Bethel will support the efforts of the Kuskokwim Campus and the University of Alaska Fairbanks to seek continuing facility operation monies for the Yup'ik Museum, Library, and Multipurpose Cultural Center.
