**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF BETHEL PROTESTING THE ISSUANCE OF A
STATE OF ALASKA ALCOHOLIC PACKAGE STORE LICENSE FOR ALASKA
COMMERCIAL COMPANY AC VALUE CENTER; 514 RIDGECREST STREET;
OWNED BY NORTH WEST COMPANY INTERNATIONAL INC.;
LICENSE ID# - 4956**

WHEREAS, based on the advisory votes cast at the January 19, 2010 City of Bethel, Special Election the citizens of Bethel voted in opposition to the issuance of all types of alcohol licensing within the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, Alaska Statutes 04.11.410 states, "A beverage dispensary or package store license may not be issued...if the licensed premises would be located in a building the public entrance of which is within 200 feet of a school ground or church in which religious services are regularly conducted", Alaska Commercial Company AC Value Center is located within 200 feet of a church where religious services are regularly conducted;


WHEREAS, Chapter 5.08.011 of the Bethel Municipal Code states, "No person may sell or offer to sell any alcoholic beverage in or within two hundred (200) ft of a church building or within two hundred (200) ft of any school grounds", Alaska Commercial Company AC Value Center is located within 200 feet of a church where religious services are regularly conducted;

WHEREAS, Chapter 5.08.011 of the Bethel Municipal Code states, "No person may sell or offer to sell any alcoholic beverage in package stores or bars within three hundred (300) ft of a church building or within three hundred (300) ft of any school grounds" Alaska Commercial Company AC Value Center is located within 300 feet of a church where religious services are regularly conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bethel City Council for the reasons set forth above, the City of Bethel does hereby protest the application for the above identified restaurant eating place liquor license and requires the City Clerk to send this resolution to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board before February 28, 2010.

ENACTED THIS 9th DAY OF FEBRUARY 2010, BY A VOTE OF 7 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
