**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel has recognized the need and importance of the Army National Guard to the Bethel region;


**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel has authorized the disposal of Lot 15, USS 4117 to the State of Alaska pursuant to the City of Bethel Ordinance No. 99-18 for the construction of a new readiness center, operational maintenance facility and memorial park in Bethel;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel desires to expand access to other properties north of the new Bethel Readiness Center and Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway to promote economic development;

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Highway Administration and the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT & PF) have asked the City of Bethel to reaffirm its support for this project and its commitment to provide for basic, routine maintenance of the access road after construction is complete;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council hereby reaffirms its support for this project and it certifies its commitment to provide support for the basic, routine maintenance of the access road after construction is complete and in accordance with a Maintenance Agreement approved by DOT & PF and the City of Bethel.
