Annually, the citizens of Bethel join together to collect the litter and debris uncovered by the Spring thaw.


This year, the volunteer campaign is being coordinated by the Clean Up, Green Up Committee, at the Bethel Youth Center.

Alaskans for Litter Prevention and Recycling (ALPAR) has generously donated garbage bags for citizen's use in this effort, and these bags are available throughout the city.


The City of Bethel will provide pick-up service to remove large items from residents' property during this campaign.
