RESOLUTION #02-28

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SOLID WASTE AND SEWAGE LAGOON FACILITIES DESIGN STUDY/MASTER PLAN AND STATING THE THREE TOP PRIORITIES OF THE SOLID WASTE AND SEWER LAGOON FACILITY, AS DETERMINED BY IMMEDIATE AND CRITICAL NEED

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of the community of Bethel and has determined the Bethel Water and Sewer Improvements project to be a priority for the community; and

WHEREAS, the City with CH2M Hill completed the Solid Waste and Sewage Lagoon Facilities Design Study/Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes and concurs with the necessary replacement of the failing main lift station as the number one priority of the Bethel Solid Waste/Sewer Lagoon plan; and

WHEREAS, with more than 200,000 gallons of flow of waste water per day into the sewage lagoon, the City also recognizes and concurs that the sewer lagoon has reached a critical need due to infiltration and alternate needs of treatment are needed; and

WHEREAS, the City further recognizes and concurs that to prolong the life of the landfill alternative means of collection and processing are needed. Among the alternative means is the immediate need to obtain a new compactor and baler facility, as well as to continue with the vertical expansion of the existing solid waste facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel hereby recognizes these three priorities as being immediate and critical to provide adequate sanitation for the residents; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the City Council of Bethel fully supports efforts to secure funding to meet these needs.
