A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE BETHEL FIRE DEPARTMENT IN SEEKING GRANT MONEY

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department has identified grant monies from the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and is willing to put forth the effort needed to apply for a grant, and;

WHEREAS, The Department of Natural Resources has the authority to carry out an initiative— Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) program—to provide funds to organize, train or equip local firefighting forces for fire protection in rural areas, and;

WHEREAS, This assistance will be awarded directly to local fire departments on a competitive basis, and;

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department identified firefighting equipment as a need that would be met by the VFA program, and;

WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department would use the grant money to purchase specific firefighting equipment for the Fire Department, and;


WHEREAS, The Bethel Fire Department is in need of additional monies to fund firefighting equipment for the safety and protection of the Bethel community.
