Ordinance #06-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PLANNING OFFICE FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE FOR ELECTRONIC COPIES OF THE BETHEL ADDRESS MAP, APPLICATION OF ZONING CHANGE, AND BASIC GIS DATA IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined that the City of Bethel Planning Department offers services not currently addressed in the fees and charges schedule;

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined these services are requested by individuals and businesses;

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined that these services provided by the Planning Department are of value;

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined that the fees associated with these services should be based on the cost of the most similar services currently provided;

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined that the current \$15.00 charge for a hard copy of the Bethel Address map is most representative of the cost to provide an electronic copy;

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined that the current cost of \$100 for the submittal of a preliminary plat is most representative of the cost to apply for rezoning;

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel has determined that the current cost of \$200.00 for an electronic reproduction of a plat is most representative of the cost to provide basic GIS map layers in electronic format;


THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

Planning fees and charges schedule be amended to include the charge of \$15.00 to provide the City address map in PDF format, \$100.00 fee for submittal of rezoning request, and \$200.00 fee to provide basic GIS map layers in electronic format.
