A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,000.00 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING A MODEL HEALTH CLINIC IN BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the need for a medical care system outside of the Public Health Service system exists in the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has determined the viability of a community health center; and

WHEREAS, present funding for the Bethel Model Health Clinic will need to be supplemented in order for the City to provide a creative and fully equipped family medical health clinic; and


WHEREAS, certain agreements and arrangements will need to be developed with the Public Health Service to provide private physicians in the City of Bethel guaranteed access to the Bethel PHS Hospital,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, supports the request for a supplementary appropriation of \$90,000.00 from the State of Alaska to the City of Bethel to be used to implement a Model Health Care Clinic whose agreements with the Public Health Service can be emulated by other rural communities throughout Alaska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
