RESOLUTION #97-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING LEGISLATION TO STANDARDIZE THE COLORS USED FOR MARKING WINTER TRAILS.

WHEREAS, Bethel Search and Resuce finds that there are inconsistencies in marking winter trails; and

WHEREAS, Bethel Search and Resuce finds that these inconsistencies may cause a hazard to the public; and

WHEREAS, Bethel Search and Rescue finds that these hazards may cause a loss of life to the traveling public

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel Alaska, respectfully requests the Alaska State Legislature to pass legislation standardizing the colors used for marking winter trails; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following colors be used to represent the corresponding conditions:

White.....	Good
Red.....	Caution
Green.....	Shelter
Blue.....	Open Water
Orange.....	Trail
