### A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council is the governing body of the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that the health and safety of the residents of Bethel depend upon improved sanitation systems and desires to these facilities for the residents of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation/Village Safe Water Program can provide the technical assistance necessary to improve sanitation systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that the following water and sewer projects are identified as the City of Bethel's priority list for funding requests through Village Safe Water Program:


