

RESOLUTION NUMBER **237**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL URGING THE GOVERNOR'S SIGNATURE ON SB 541, SB 542, SB 543, SB 552.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, the Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation, and the Southcentral Health Planning Development Agency have identified alcohol abuse and alcoholism as a major health problem in this community and region; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has passed SB 541, an act dealing with alcohol education in the public schools from grades kindergarten through the 12th grade; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has passed SB 542, an act appropriating funds to the State Office of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse for training and program development; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has passed SB 543, an act allowing for the expansion of the existing state funded alcoholism programs, development and implementation of a follow-up study on these programs, and provision for administration personnel in the State Office of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has passed SB 552, an act relating the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated statutes through the development and expansion of the prevention and treatment efforts; and


WHEREAS, there is a need for increased efforts to effectively deal with alcohol abuse and alcoholism throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, the residents of this community and region would benefit from the effects of these bills if signed into law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Bethel strongly urges Governor Jay Hammond to enact SB 541, SB 542, SB 543, and SB 552 into law.


