## RESOLUTION #94-26

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, SUPPORTING EQUAL ACCESS TO HOUSING FOR ALL PERSONS

WHEREAS, discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, family status, or national origin is prohibited by Title VIII of the 1968 Civil Rights Act (Federal Fair Housing Law) in the sale, rental, leasing, and/or financing of housing or land to be used for construction of housing, or in the provision of brokerage services; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Bethel to implement programs to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, family status, or national origin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is the policy of the City of Bethel to assist all persons who feel they have been discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, family status, or national origin to seek equity under federal and state laws by filing a complaint with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Seattle Regional Office Compliance Division.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Bethel shall publicize this Resolution and through this publicity shall cause owners of real estate, developers and builders to become aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under the Federal Fair Housing Law and any applicable state or local laws or ordinances.

Said program will at a minimum include, but not be limited to:

1. the printing and publicizing of this policy and other applicable fair housing information through local media and community contracts;
2. distribution and/or display of posters, flyers, and any other means which will bring to the attention of those affected, the knowledge of their respective responsibilities and rights concerning equal opportunity on housing.

This Resolution takes effect immediately.
