MMS Gamble/Swanson to continue meeting as necessary. MC

MMS Shantz/Swanson to put the contents of the contract deleting item 3, in the form of an Ordinance, and post as such, and asking that all those that are interested in the terms of this Ordinance to please send their proposals to the City Council by the next meeting. In addition to the terms already in the contract, warm storage should be added. Materials to be provided by the City, manpower and labor to install Materials, plus oil to be paid for by the Lessee. MC

Bids to be received by the 27th day of August, 1962, the bids to be opened and the lowest bid if under this amount be accepted, if over to be carried over till the next regular City Council meeting.
