

CALL TO ORDER

The Special Meeting of the Bethel City Council was called to order at 1.30 pm.

ROLL CALL

Present: Binkley, Buttane, Guinn, Hoffman, Pavil, Twitchell

Absent: Anvil (work)

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

M/M by Twitchell, 2nd by Hoffman to accept the agenda as presented. Voice vote, motion carried.

At the request of Councilmember Twitchell, James Barker of the Museum Committee addressed Council as to the need to relocate the museum. No action was taken by Council at this time.

NEW BUSINESS

PROTECTIVE CUSTODY

Item A: Protective Custody

City Manager Hoffman requested an executive session with the City Attorney concerning protective custody. M/M by Pavil, 2nd by Twitchell to go into executive session. Voice vote, motion carried. Executive session from 1.39 to 2.45 pm.

M/M by Guinn, 2nd by Hoffman directing the City Administration to request an emergency meeting on behalf of the Administration, City Council, and AVCP with Governor Sheffield on the issue of protective custody. Voice vote, motion carried.

Item B: Personnel Matter

PERSONNEL MATTER - DETOX CLOSURE

City Manager Hoffman reviewed for Council the staff reductions that will result with the anticipated closure of the Detox/CSP unit of PATC.

A discussion followed as to the procedure the City would follow with respect to those employees affected by the closure. M/M by Buttane, 2nd by Hoffman to:

- a. close detox/CSP as of Sept. 1, 1983;
- b. provide each employee affected by the closure 2 weeks separation pay;
- c. place each employee layed off by the closure on recall status per Administration policy.

The Administration expressed concern with the motion in that the policy to be followed had not been finalized prior to the making of the motion. Councilmember Binkley opposed the motion. After discussion, the maker and 2nd of the motion withdrew the motion from consideration.

Council recessed from 3.33 to 3.38 pm.

NEW BUSINESS CONT

PERSONNEL MATTER - DETOX CLOSURE

motion

M/M by Buttane, 2nd by Hoffman that the Detox/CSP unit of PATC cease operations as of midnight, August 31, 1983. Voice vote, 5 yes, 1 no, motion carried.

motion

M/M Buttane, 2nd by Hoffman that employees layed off by the closure of Detox/CPS be given 2 weeks separation pay. A discussion followed on the motion concerning who would be eligible to receive the separation pay.

motion

M/M by Buttane, 2nd by Hoffman to add to the main motion the clause....if not re-employed by the City within 15 days. Poll vote, motion carried.

Poll vote taken on the amended main motion that employees layed off by the closure of PATC Detox/CPS unit be given 2 weeks separation pay if not re-employed by the City within 15 days. 4 yes, 1 no, Binkley passed. After the vote was taken, Councilmember Binkley voted yes and moved for reconsideration at the next Council meeting. Motion passed and the item was set for discussion at the next Council meeting.

M/M by Pavil to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 3.55 pm.
