RESOLUTION #00-29

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FORGIVENESS OF THE BALANCE OF A LOAN OWED BY BETHEL FAMILY CLINIC DATING BACK TO 1984

WHEREAS, in April of 1984 the Bethel Family Clinic, finding itself in a financial bind, formally requested financial assistance from the Bethel City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel granted Bethel Family Clinic's request and provided a \$50,000 loan; and

WHEREAS, Bethel Family Clinic, between 1985 and 1993, repaid approximately \$34,459 of the loan payable, according to the City's records; and

WHEREAS, Bethel Family Clinic has struggled and continues to struggle financially, and is requesting that the City forgive the remainder of the loan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel recognizes that Bethel Family Clinic, as a private provider of medical services in Bethel, provides vital services of great necessity to the community; and


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is desirous to assist Bethel Family Clinic in this matter.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council agrees to forgive the approximate \$14,000 loan payable to the City of Bethel, as recorded on the books of Bethel Family Clinic, and \$15,531 loan receivable, as recorded in the City's financial records.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution, the balance of the loan payable by Bethel Family Clinic to the City of Bethel shall be considered forgiven and paid in full.
