SUPPORT FOR THE PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF SFY 2012 ALASKA COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and Orutsararmiut Native Council are partners in the funding and operation of the Bethel Public Transit System;

WHEREAS, the Bethel Public Transit System depends on grant funding for its continued operation;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, is currently accepting SFY 2012 grant applications requesting funds to cover administrative, operating, and/or capital expenses of public transportation systems in the state;


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel applied for and received \$261,503 in SFY 2011 and intends to apply for the maximum amount, as determined by state formula, in this application;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel will make an effort to use in-kind resources as match and rely on expenditures paid with Indian Reservation Roads from ONC for its required match;

WHEREAS, applications are due April 11, 2011 for the grant period: July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council supports the preparation and submission of an SFY 2012 Alaska Community Transportation, Public Transportation grant application to request funds that support the operation of the Bethel Public Transit System.
