#### **A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 FOR C.O.P.S. UNIVERSAL HIRING PROGRAM**


**WHEREAS,** the City of Bethel wishes to hire two police officers to work in schools; and

**WHEREAS,** the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), offers grants to local law enforcement agencies thereby providing incentives for those local law enforcement agencies to build working relationships with schools to use community policing efforts to combat school violence; and

**WHEREAS,** the Local Advisory School Board has given its support for this program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that Robert Herron, City Manager for the City of Bethel, is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and grants required for granting funds to the Bethel Police Department. Further, Robert Herron is also authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to said grant to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the project.
