

CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING AND IMPLEMENTING EXISTING STATE STATUTES, INCLUDING SECTION 18.55.750, AND EXISTING CODE PROVISIONS INCLUDING SUBCHAPTER 9 OF TITLE 7 OF THE ALASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

WHEREAS, Section 18.55.750 of Alaska Statutes and Subchapter 9, Title 7, of the Alaska Administrative Code have been effective and part of the powers and program of the City of Bethel for more than six months, and

WHEREAS, a Uniform Housing Code has heretofore been adopted by the City of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Housing Code and the Alaska Plumbing Code have heretofore been adopted by the Department of Health and Safety of the State of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore determined that a large number of human habitations in the City are "unfit" within the meaning of the pertinent administrative code provisions and state statutes, including Section 18.55.750, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy and determination of the City to actively and directly promote safe, sanitary housing for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the residents, NOW, THEREFORE, it is enacted:

Section 1. That the inspection of properties, and the repair, closing, demolition or removal of unfit dwellings, as well as the construction of new and suitable housing, shall be undertaken, so far as practicable, utilizing the powers of the City as detailed in Sections 480-960 of Chapter 55, Title 18, Alaska Statutes, and in conformity with the Alaska Housing Code and the Alaska Plumbing Code, Subchapter 9, Title 7, Alaska Administrative Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its passage, approval and publication. Publication of this ordinance shall be by posting a copy thereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten days following its passage and approval.
