A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING OWNERSHIP, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION RESPONSIBILITY OF STANDARD OIL ROAD IN EXCHANGE FOR ADVANCING THE RECONSTRUCTION AND RESURFACING OF PTARMIGAN STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is committed to achieving the best possible road system to serve the city's residents and visitors; and,

WHEREAS, adequate transportation facilities are essential for residents' quality of life and a healthier environment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in compliance with the Federal Highway funding in the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) seeks to serve the needs of local communities; and

WHEREAS, Ptarmigan Road is owned and maintained by the City of Bethel, is in poor condition and reconstruction and resurfacing will significantly reduce City maintenance and operations costs and improve health and quality of life of area residents by eliminating a source contributing to significant dust problem; and

WHEREAS, the Ptarmigan Street Improvement project is programmed in the 2001-2003 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for preliminary engineering funding in FFY 2002 and construction funding in FFY 2005; and

WHEREAS, Standard Oil Road is state-owned and maintained and connects the Petro Port to Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of ownership and maintenance responsibility of another DOT&PF facility will increase the score of the Ptarmigan Street Improvement Project (project ID # 2227), and will advance its construction in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.


