**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR THE FY94 ANTI-DRUG ABUSE GRANT - MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL TASK FORCE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel desires to participate in Department of Public Safety, Division of State Troopers, Statewide Drug Enforcement Unit's Multi-jurisdictional Task Force through the Drug Control and System Improvement Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Multi-jurisdictional Task Force will consist of an Investigator from the City of Bethel Police Department and the Alaska State Troopers, State-Wide Drug Enforcement Unit to address the drug and alcohol issues in the Bethel area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alaska Department of Public Safety has a grant program to make funds available to the City of Bethel to cover 75% of the expenses necessary to undertake the tasks set forth in the FY 1994 project proposal, and

**WHEREAS**, the City expects that the total participation cost will be in the amount of \$62,312; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel agrees to pay the participation cost of \$15,578, an amount equal to 25% of the total participation cost;

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the City of Bethel to receive and use the funds allocated for the approved tasks.




